What is the role of 21st Century MND and is Regulator focus on diversity a help or a hindrance?

Are we taking the easy way out when it's too difficult to find MNTs? Should we instead be looking at what we need to change to mean MNT selection becomes a positive addition to any Trustee Board. This seminar will look at why engaging members is still so important and that it isn't all about the professionals.

We regularly hear about the difficulties in attracting Member Nominated Trustees (MNTs) to a Trustee Board. We hear about the challenges of Trusteeship and how getting Members interested is getting harder. The Regulator may well say they want Boards to actively look to increase their diversity and inclusivity, but it may be hard to achieve when getting ANY member representation is a challenge.

Yet existing Member Trustees often speak about how the role is interesting and challenging. A role they feel helps their career development and where their project management, research and team building skills are all highly valued.

We will be joined by Eleanor Daplyn, a partner at Sacker & Partners, who is also one of the Partner Champions for Diversity and Inclusion. Eleanor will be looking at what diversity can mean in practice in the context of a pension scheme, what we really mean by the benefits of diversity and how it can add value to the governance and operation of a Trustee Board.

Lucy Tindal, who leads Pi's secretariat service and prior to joining Pi was Pensions Manager for the Parliamentary Schemes, will share her experience of running MND exercises, practical ways of promoting the role and why Trustee Boards can not only support corporate aims on diversity but be one of the flagships.
